COURSE INFORMATION

FR347 NORMANDY THROUGH THE AGES is a 2-credit Global Seminar that can be taken in conjunction with a 2-credit spring course with the same title, *FR346 Normandy Through the Ages*. This Global Seminar will take students to Normandy and Paris, France and will feature four major topics introduced in the spring FR346 course and developed further during this 10-day trip. The themes include: *William the Conqueror and Medieval Normandy*; *Literary Normandy: Famous Writers from the Age of Realism and Naturalism*; *Normandy, Birthplace of Impressionism*; and *World War II: D-Day and the Battle of Normandy*. This course is open to all students and will be taught in English.
